



SHELL & DRIFTWOOD WIND CHIME FORAGE ART ACTIVITY

DIRECTED EXPLORATION OF THE PARK
FOR AGES 4+



SUPPLIES

Piece of driftwood
(any size will do)

Twine
(thicker twine for hanging the windchime)

String
(or thread, or dental floss)

Shells!
(any shell with holes in them already so you don't
have to drill holes)

FORAGE!

Head down to the many beaches around the park

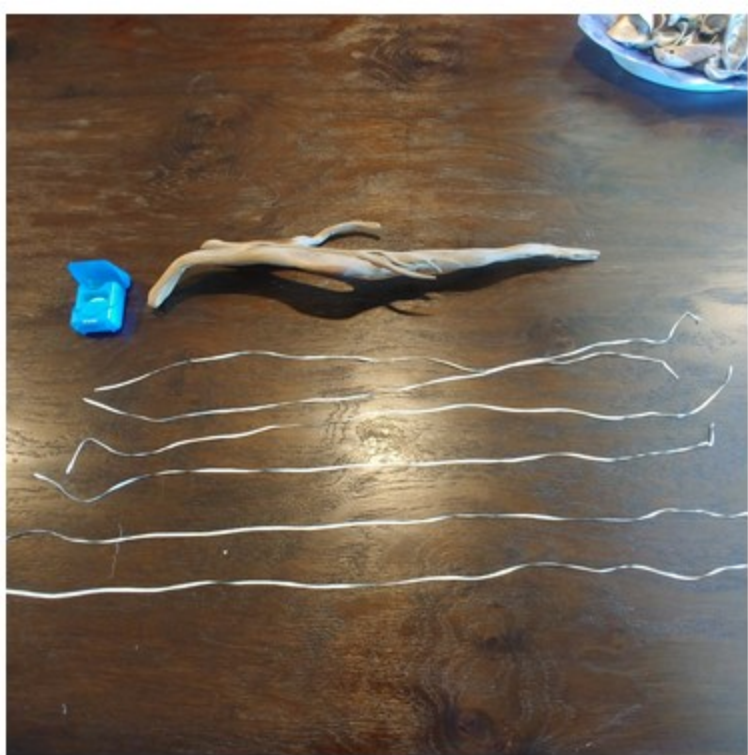
Find a piece of dry wood and a bunch of shells (preferably ones that already have holes in them!)



STEP 1

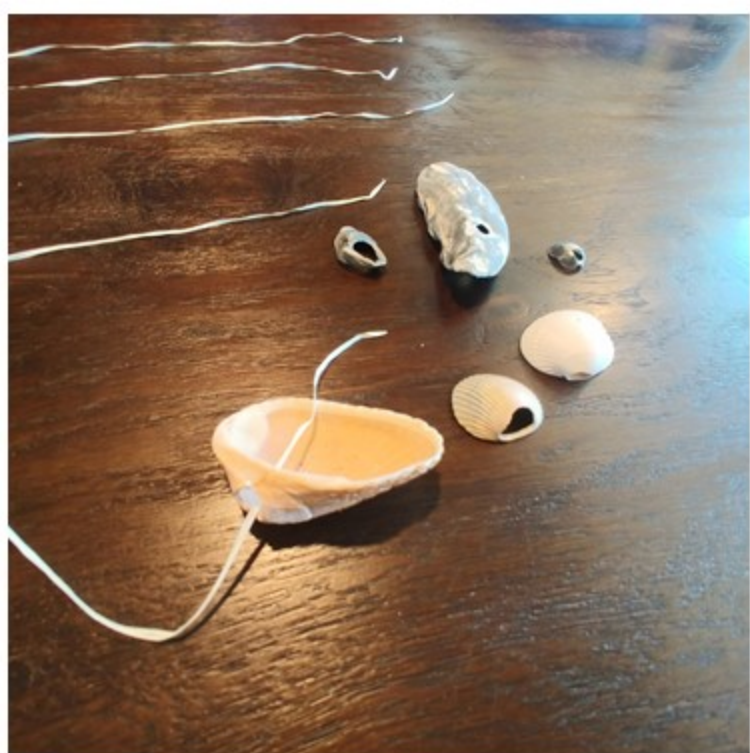
Cut 5 or 6 pieces of string (or dental floss!) about 2 feet long

Tie them on to your piece of driftwood



STEP 2

Start tying
your shells
on your
string,
starting at
the end
closest to
the
driftwood



STEP 3

Tie 4 or 5 shells on to each of your strings

If you can end each string with a large shell, they will catch the wind easier!



STEP 4

Cut a piece of twine to hand your windchime & tie a loop knot on the end of it



STEP 5

Tie your twine to either end of your driftwood and hang it up!
