Worksheet for recording experiences at each station, wrap up discussion and drawing conclusions, re-searching more aspects of one station

LETTER WRITING WITH A POV

Examining historical text, discussion and reading secondary source background information, considering POV of letter, composing text based on imagination and historical knowledge, revising with peers, sharing with class, publishing

PREPARING AND TASTING FOOD

Reading historic recipes, class discussion, researching other recipes and related topics.

Venn diagram and class discussion comparing artworks, drawing conclusions from class observations, creating an art inspired poem, revisions with peers, reading aloud
